GRANTS FOR FARROWED SOWS IN WESTERN COUNTIES

A new Farrowed Sow Scheme, confined to Western counties (Cavan, Clare, Donegal, Galway, Kerry, Mayo, Monaghan, Leitrim, Longford, Roscommon, Sligo and West Cork) will replace the existing Scheme due to end on 30th June. New grants of £10 per sow will be payable in two instalments of £6 each on farrowings occurring at least 12 months apart. The maximum is 6 grants per herd so that over the period of the Scheme — 1st July, 1968, to 31st December, 1972 — a producer may qualify for total grants amounting to 160.

Application forms W.S.1. may be obtained from Post Offices, Land Project District Officers, District Veterinary Offices, Offices of County Committees of Agriculture, Garda Stations, or direct from the Department of Agriculture, and Fisheries.
