AT "BULLDOZING
TACTICS" OF C.I.E.**

A deputation comprising of ten farmers from Ballinacorney, County Tipperary, met on Monday afternoon to discuss the proposed laying of a new railway line through their lands. The deputation was led by Mr. J. Walsh, a local farmer. They expressed their strong opposition to the proposed line, which they felt would be a "bulldozing" tactic by the C.I.E. to acquire land for a railway line. They argued that the line would be a waste of money and would do little good for the area. They also expressed their concern about the impact of the line on the local environment and the local economy.

Members of a deputation from Waterford County Executive N.F.A., which attended last Monday's meeting of Waterford County Council in Dungarvan, strongly criticised the decision of the Council to borrow £200,000 to finance a water scheme for the proposed new £200,000 Magnesian Industry at Ballinacorney, County Tipperary. The deputation, which included Mr. D. J. Coghlan, Kilmactochas, chief spokesman; Mr. James Ryan, Liscannell, and Mr. J. M. Walsh, Dungarvan, expressed their strong opposition to the proposed scheme. They argued that the scheme was a waste of money and would do little good for the area. They also expressed their concern about the impact of the scheme on the local environment and the local economy.

was no underhand work in any shape or form. Mr. J. Walsh, T.D., said it was his belief that what they would contribute to this industry would be repaid over and over again. From rates alone they would have a yearly income of about £21,000 and for the Council for the water scheme that was an excellent investment from the ratepayers' point of view. Mr. Coghlan on behalf of the deputation, thanked the Council for having received them, and for hearing their case. The Chairman said the N.F.A. were always welcome visitors at Council meetings. No decision was taken by the Council to withdraw its financial support to the water scheme.
