INCREASES IN SOCIAL INSURANCE BENEFITS AND CONTRIBUTIONS

The Social Welfare (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1968, provides for presents from the beginning of January, 1969, in the races of benefits and reasons under the Social Insurance scheme, for our additional payment for ortain incapacitated pensioners and for crossoguential increases in the rates footbrillium.

INCREASES IN RATES OF BENEFITS AND PENSIONS

The personal rates of Disability Benefit, Unemployment Benefit Materalty Allowance, Widow's (Contributory) Pension, Orphan's (Contributory) Allowance and Old Age (Contributory) Pension William (Contributory) Allowance and Old Age (Contributory) Pension will be increased by 7/6d. a week. The rates of allowances for adult dependants will also be increased by 7/6d. end the rates for qualified children by 2/6d.

The increase of Unemployment Benefit is in the ordinary weekly rates. Corresponding increases were given last August to claimants in receipt of special rate Unemployment Benefit. The increases of Pensions and of Orphan's Allowance will be payable from Friday, 3rd January, 1969, and the increases of Disability and Unemployment Benefit and Maternity Allowances will be payable from Monday, 6th January, 1969.

Payment at the appropriate increased rates will be made without special application.

INCREASE OF PENSION FOR INCAPACITATED PENSIONERS
