The letter stated that the county Executives of N.F.A and Macra ma Feirme always wished to cooperate in a control scheme and suggested that a meeting of all interested bodies and commercial interests be called to set up a subcommittee to organise and run the scheme.

Mr. S. Whelan said that it seemed to him that the NFA were just killing time as the points raised in their letter had already been covered at a previous meeting called for this purpose. They should now get ahead and kill the pigeons. "We did everything in our power to get this scheme going," he said, "but we did not get a lot of cooperation from the NFA in the matter."
