Complete now your final preparations for Decimal Day
In order to change to decimal working in your shop or business you will need to:
- stock the till with bronze decimal coins (1p, 1p and 2p) for change-giving. These new coins are available from all bank branches;
- complete the training of staff and give them practice in handling the new coins;
- see that necessary decimal machines (such as cash registers or price-computing scales) are ready OR prepare one of the easy and inexpensive temporary methods of using a non-decimal machine for decimal trading. (Detailed advice on stop-gap expedients is available - see below);
- display in your shop the Shopping Conversion Table which is to be used for the conversion of retail prices generally;
- check over all other preparations needed in your business.
