

School Year 1971/72 Notice to Parents and Guardians

The purpose of the free transport scheme is to pro-to the opportunity of post-primary education for child-n in rural areas who live an excessive distance from the nearest post-primary school.

Under the terms of the scheme, children I under the terms of the screens, critical range miles or more from the nearest centre at which free education is available are eligible for transport to the centre provided they qualify for recognition as past-primary pupils. To qualify for such recognition the public must

(a) enrol in a post-primary school "recognised by the Minister for Education;

(b) be not less than twelve years of age on Is January, 1972;
(c) as a rule have completed sixth standard in

a national school or its equivalent. Eligible pupils commencing post-primary education in September, 1971 should apply for transport without delay on a special form which they can obtain from the headmaster or headmistress of the post-primary school,

at which they propose to attend.

Eligible pupils at present attending post-primary schools will be given an application form by their head master or headmistress.

Eligible pupils intending to commence a Leavi Certificate course from September, 1971 at a centre other than that in which they studied for their Intermediate Certificate should apply for a transport appli-cation form to the headmaster or headmistress of their new school.

Since the preparatory arrangements take a able time, pupils must complete and return the application forms to their headmaster or headmastress before 14th May, 1971. Parents should note that eligibility for free transpor
