PROPOSALS FOR ABBEYSIDE BRIDGE

Understand that before long proposals of present being planned will be carried out to the Abbeyside Bridge which has been the subject of a deal of controversy in the past.

Now I think that the Co. Engineer, Mr. J. D. Holly has come up with a solution which should go a long way towards satisfying everyone.

I believe that this will make the bridge a much safer place to negotiate and the new plans which I understand, will be put into operation early next spring will, I also feel, be welcomed by those many users who at present have to walk or cycle over it with fear and trepidation.

THE NEW ROLE OF THE DOCTOR

The following is quoted in a leading article headed "Medicine And The Mass Media" in the current issue of the "Irish Medical Times" and is of interest in view of the structure of the new regional health boards and the greater role of the doctor in public administration.

"In more recent years, with the increasing centralisation of health services and bureaucracy becoming more widespread, doctors are being more and more involved in the administrative side of medicine, as members of councils, committees and boards.

"Life being what it is, the same doctors may find themselves being quoted frequently in the mass media, particularly if they sponsor controversial views or run counter to the herd. By so doing, they may leave themselves open to charges of advertising, not always based on the purest of motives.

"We think there must be provision for the doctor who wishes to express his views openly, in a responsible manner, for many medical problems have political solutions. We are afraid that, as things are at present, doctors may be inhibited from making valuable contributions towards the solution of medical, social and political problems by fear of accusations of infringing our professional code concerning advertising."

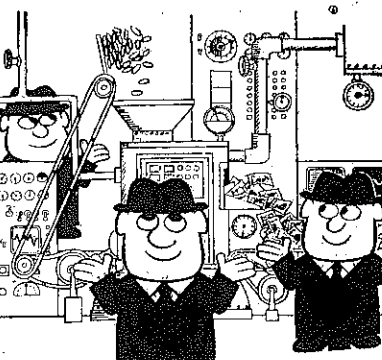
