

JANUARY LIVESTOCK COUNT Significant Increase In Cattle Numbers

Results of the January 1972 enumeration of livestock show increases in the numbers of cattle, sheep and poultry and a small decline in pig numbers.

The most significant feature was the continuing increase in cattle stocks particularly in the breeding herd which accounted for 98,000 of the total increase of 111,000. This reflects the confidence of farmers in prospects for milk and beef. Total cattle numbers were 5,516,000 as compared with 5,405,000 in January, 1971.

INCREASE IN EWES
Sheep numbers at 2,862,300 were 26,500 higher than a year ago, notwithstanding the high slaughterings in 1971. The most satisfactory feature was the rise of 44,000 in ewe numbers.

There was a sharp rise in the numbers of poultry—1,348,200 or 15% million.

The number of pigs showed a slight drop of 12,000 to 1,443,500.

This was not entirely unexpected in view of the high level of slaughterings last year.




