Next Sunday, December 10, has been chosen throughout the country, as Road Safety Sunday. The purpose, of course, is to focus attention on the increasing sloughter which is taking place on our roads in an effort to reduce, in some way, the number of fotal accidents. Here in County Worderford, the County Road Safety Officer, Merite White Dungarvan, is arganising a programme to cover the situation while special sermons on the subject will be preached in all churches.

It is indeed a most terrifying truth that in 1971 the roads was 576. The total of road deaths for this year is expected to exceed 600, It is ogim thought when it is realised that these figures represent the equivalent or wiping out the entire population of a small town in Ireland every year. The causes of accidents are many—excessive speed, care-The causes of accidents are many—excessive speed, core-lessness or aggressiveness by drivers, motor and pedal cyclists and pedestrians—but one single factor, however, stands out in the statistics as a major contributory cause in rood accidents—particularly fatal accidents—drinking and driving:

In this Country it has been established that the risk of being killed or injured in a road accident is aver seven times as great between 11 p.m. und 12 midnight compared with daylight hours.
