





ARE BLOOD TESTS

INFALLIBLE?

Much publicity has been given in togeth months to the new gentant speent months to the new gentant speent months to the new gentant speent months to the case togeth with driving, while under the influence of alcohol and who opt for blood tests. When these blood trests subsequently show an alcohol concentration in the blood in excess of the legally permitted amount conviction almost automatically follows. However a recent case has shown that motorists who agree to submit to such the state could well be ruining their chances of avoiding the disqualification which is a significant when a conviction is recorded.

For all blood somples are

recorded.

For all blood samples are sent to the Medical Bureau of Road Safety in Dublin and, while server where the Bureau is concerned is the exception rather than the rule, all convictions are based on the findings of the Bureau.

Under the Act it is the option of a defendant to ask for a doctor of his own choice to examine him and take blood; lests—one for the authorities and one which he can retain for private anolysis. But in regard to the latter it has been shown that it is virtually impossible for the private individual to have a sample of his blood privately tested.
