INVOICES VALUE-AD. The Revenue Commissioners value persons of the vital importance of the value-added tax system. A tax invoice must include particulars: (a) the name and address of the person issuing it; (b) the name and address of the person to whom it is issued; (c) the date of issue of the invoice; (d) the date of supply of the goods or services; (e) the full description of the goods or services; (f) the total of the tax-exceptible value of the goods or services; (g) the amount of tax chargeable thereon; (h) the amount of tax paid; (i) the name and address of the person to whom the invoice is issued; (j) the name and address of the person to whom the invoice is issued.

INVOICES AND VALUE-ADDED TAX

The Revenue Commissioners wish to remind accountable persons of the vital importance of invoices under the value-added tax system. They are the documents which authorize accountable persons to deduct tax charged to them by suppliers.
