## PENSMAN TAKES YOU Behind the SPOTLIGHT

### APPEAL FOR TROCAIRE

The season of Lent, the traditional period set aside by the Church for prayer and self-denial, is once again with us. This year our bishop, Most Rev. Dr. Russell, lays special stress in his Lenten Pastoral (published in full elsewhere in this issue) on the need for a growth in the number of vocations to the priesthood and the religious life and has appealed to the faithful to offer their sacrifices and prayers towards that end.

There is a great need for more priests to spread the Good News of Christ especially to the people of the Third World and one of the best ways in which lay people can involve themselves in this is through their contributions to Trocaire. They are being afforded an opportunity to show their generosity in this regard again this year through the Trocaire Family Fast Boxes.

Each household can obtain one of these, if they have not already done so, and each member of the family, by little acts of self-denial, can throughout the season of Lent, make regular contributions to these fast boxes and so show their genuine concern for this great and worthy cause.

Last year the Parish of Dungarvan with a total collection of £1066 topped the Trocaire Fast Box collections in the entire diocese and the Priests of the Parish hopefully look to a similar response from the people this year.

### CAPPOQUIN/LISMORE WATER SUPPLY

The water supply position in the Cappoquin/Lismore areas has been the cause of a great deal of dissatisfaction for the people in those areas for a considerable time back. Public meetings have been held to protest about the position and deputations have attended meetings of Waterford County Council in an effort to have something done to bring about an improvement.

A report from the County Engineer, Mr. J. D. Hally, which was placed before last week's meeting of the Council admitted that the existing regional scheme from present sources was unable to meet the full current demand for water in these areas and that unless additional sources could be obtained and brought into operation before the summer the areas would again be faced with a serious shortage.

However the report outlined the work which had been done to ensure that such a shortage would not again recur in the following terms: "A suitable borehole source has been found at Ballyhane. It is proposed to pump water from this borehole into the existing pipe network. The estimated capital cost is £5,000. Another borehole has been sunk in Cappoquin, and while the quantity of water available is satisfactory, the

## OVER 200 YEW TREES IN COUNTY BURIAL GROUNDS

The case of a farmer in the Knockanore area of Talloow who suffered heavy financial losses when several of his cattle broke into a local cemetery and died after eating some poisonous yew trees was again mentioned at the monthly meeting of the County Waterford Committee of Agriculture held in Dungarvan last Monday. At a previous meeting a call was made for the removal of these trees from the county area under the control of the County Council. The matter was referred to them and in any event it is doubtful if the problem is worth this expenditure apart altogether from the fact that normally it is a farmer's own responsibility to ensure that his cattle are adequately fenced in.

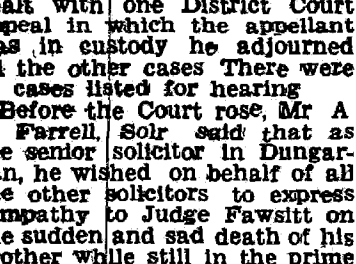
