Mr Conway said that analyses by the State Laboratory of samples of the composted fertiliser (15N-25P-12K) presently on sale here show that over half of the Nitrogen in this fertiliser is Urea Nitrogen and this would directly drilled with cereal seeds could have adverse effects on germination.

It is essential, therefore, that grain growers familiarise themselves with the exact nutrient contents of fertilizer before purchase as a mistake may involve a large financial loss.

Mr Conway advised that if any doubt, farmers should consult their local Agricultural Adviser.

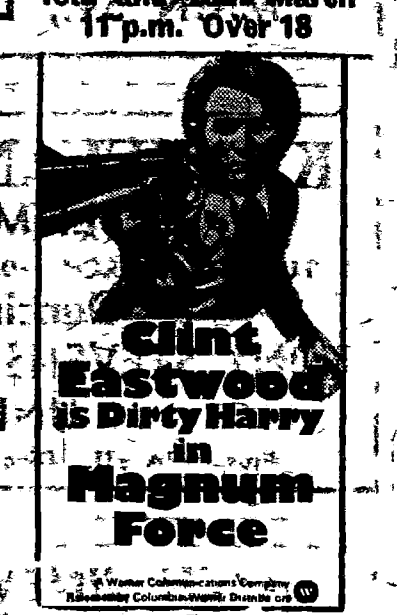

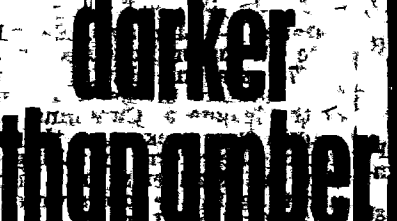
