INQUEST SEQUEL TO FATAL BALLYMACARBRY ACCIDENT

An inquest into the circumstances surrounding the death of 49 year old Patrick Halley, single farmer of Clashavouga Ballymacarbry which occurred at Ballymacarbry on Sunday night, September 12 last, was held by Dr T J McMahon, Carrigrohane, Acting Coroner for West Waterford sitting with a jury at the Court House, Dungarvan, last Friday. The members of the jury were Messrs John O'Donnell (foreman), Liam Morrissey, Nicholas Casey, Michael Lenders, Seán Baumann, Joseph Power, Patrick Walsh, John Doyle, Michael Tynan and E J Keyes. Michael McCarthy, farmer, of Clashavouga Ballymacarbry gave evidence that at 10.30 p.m. on the night in question he was driving through Ballymacarbry V-Page in the direction of Dungarvan as he entered the road he noticed an object on the road and was very near it when he realised that it was a man lying on the road with his head and shoulders on wheels. As he passed he noticed what he thought was a large stout bottle lying on the road. He drove on for about ten or fifteen yards beyond him but before he could get out of his car he saw the car which was coming behind him go over the man. When he went back he saw that the man was unconscious but breathing. Michael Walsh farmer, Clonagarr, Dungarvan, in his evidence stated that he was driving through the village that night he saw the car in front of him slow down and swerve to the left. He then saw a man lying in the middle of the road. When he passed the man he had a good look at him and he was alright and he saw any way. He reported the matter to the Gardaí at Ballymacarbry.

PUTTING THE RECORD STRAIGHT

A letter to the Editor of this paper published in last week's issue referred to the proposal to demolish the existing bridge over the Causeway at Abbeyside and to replace it with a new modern bridge from which the existing "hump" will be removed. I have already expressed my views on this and wish to refer now merely to the letter published over the non-departmental "Dungarvan My Home Town" to put the record straight, in particular the following paragraph in it: "With the Waterford County Council and Urban Council in such bad financial straits, we now see from our local newspapers that they propose to go further into debt by borrowing the massive sum of £20,000."

WHY SHOULD RATEPAYERS HAVE TO PAY FOR THIS?

The owners of a Galway hotel which was badly damaged by a bomb last July, were awarded £81,451 at a few weeks ago, in settlement of a malicious damages claim against Galway Corporation. It will be recalled that this hotel was one of a number of targets which were blasted by bombs alleged to have been planted by a Northern Loyalist Organisation. Fortunately no one was killed in the explosion as the gardai had received a 9-minute warning of the bomb from an anonymous telephone caller and they managed to get residents and staff to safety minutes before the device exploded. When it did go off the explosion ripped through the evacuated hotel and extensive damage was done to the ground floor and to the roof of the 47 bedroom building. That the ratepayers of Galway City should now have to pay for this damage,

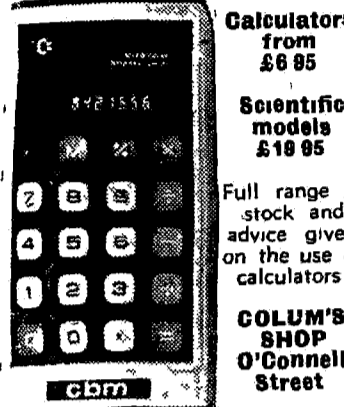
