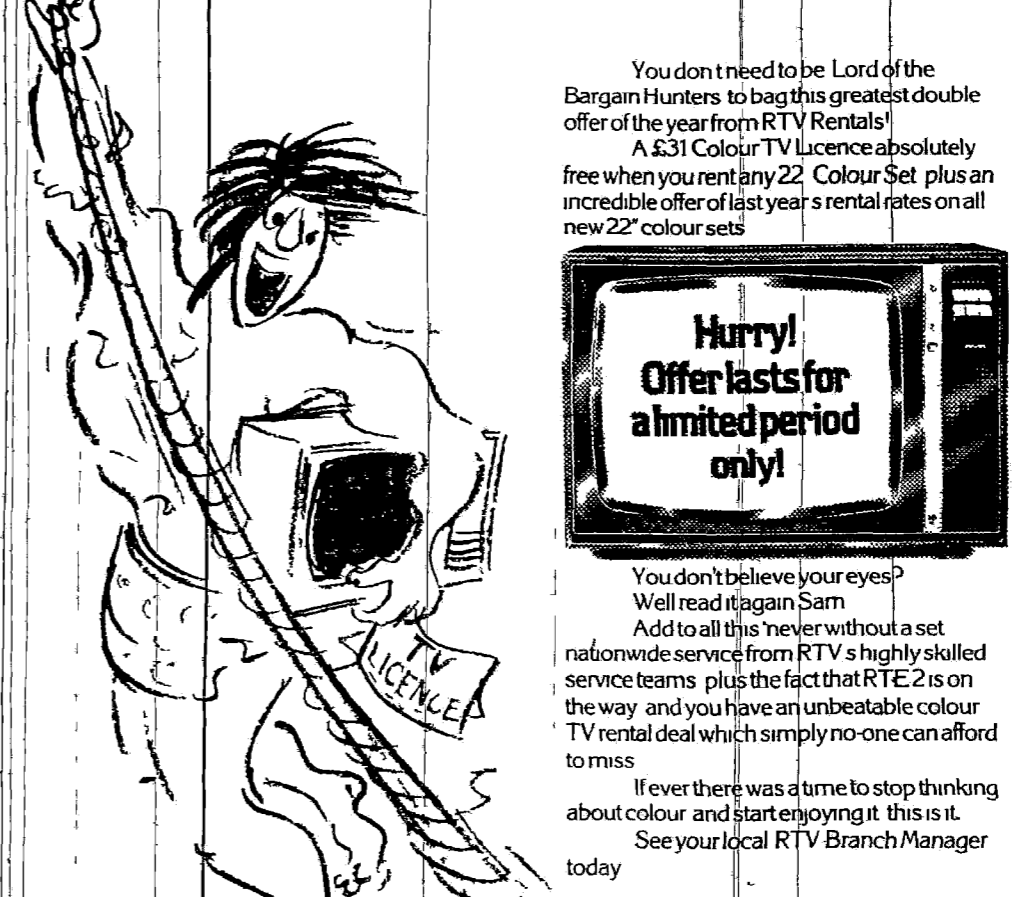

ARDMORE THROUGH TO FOOTBALL FINAL

ARDMORE 2-14, KILROSSANTY 1-8

Ardmores was anticipated to qualify for the county senior football final by defeating an unbeaten Kilrossanty side in a rather disappointing semi-final at Dungarvan on Sunday night last. The game drew a huge crowd to the venue but the majority must have left the ground dissatisfied with the over all standard of the football served up.

Although Ardmores was comprehensive in the end they had to fight off an unexpected strong challenge from a youthful Kilrossanty side and it was not until the final quarter that the St. Declan's boys secured the scores which ensured them a place in the final against either Stradbally or Dunhill. Admittedly they never played with the same fluidity which they displayed against Tramore in their quarter final replay. They are capable of far better things and it may be that they underestimated the strength of the Kilrossanty side.

They are notoriously bad starters and Sunday night was no exception as they found themselves trailing by 11 after ninety seconds. Kilrossanty's major coming from Noel Tobin within forty seconds of the start.

It was Ardmores were just a point ahead at the interval 1-5 to 1-4. Kilrossanty continued to battle on early in the second half and there was only two points in it (1-8 to 1-6) after 40 minutes. Slowly but surely however the numerical disadvantage began to take its toll on the Comeragh side and although they continued to battle on they could find no answer to the pressure which an improving Ardmores side were beginning to apply.

Gradually their stamina wilted and Ardmores came through in the final quarter to get the scores which ensured them a deserved victory. Their second goal coming from Matky Cronn just a minute before the end.
