## PENSMAN TAKES YOU behind the SPOTLIGHT

### BECOMING A REAL PROBLEM

The fact that pollution was  
 becoming a very real problem,  
 not only where our rivers and  
 lakes are concerned but also  
 in our coastal waters, was  
 brought into sharp focus at  
 the National Coastal Pollution  
 Seminar held in Cork last  
 week-end.

Mr Liam Mullins, Cork  
 County Engineer, told the  
 Seminar that up to this the  
 experts were indulging only in  
 shadow boxing. In his view  
 the Seminar was probably one  
 of the most important ever  
 held in this country but he  
 was disappointed that it con  
 sisted of a series of papers  
 rather than doing something  
 about the problem.

Dr Matt Lynch of the In  
 stitute of Industrial Research  
 and Standards stated that five  
 Irish ports or estuaries were  
 carrying 86 per cent of Ire  
 land's total pollution load,  
 he suggested that monitoring  
 should be concentrated in the  
 areas under most stress.

Dr Lynch estimated that  
 the pollution from Urban  
 populations in coastal towns  
 was increasing at a rate of 5  
 per cent per year and no  
 significant reduction seemed  
 likely.

He listed the areas with the  
 highest combined industrial  
 and domestic effluent dis  
 charges on a national per  
 centage basis as Dublin Bay  
 and County (53 per cent),  
 Cork Harbour (16 per cent),  
 the Shannon Estuary (8 per  
 cent) and Waterford Harbour  
 (26 per cent).

The factor which must  
 cause most of us in County  
 Waterford and in the Dungar  
 van area in particular who are  
 aware of this growing problem  
 must concern is that of the  
 five areas mentioned by Dr  
 Lynch where industrial waste  
 comprises the major pollutant,  
 Dungarvan harbour stands at  
 the head of the list with  
 89 per cent, followed by  
 Drogheda-Dundalk, 79 per  
 cent, Co Donegal, 67 per  
 cent, Killala Bay, 66 per cent  
 and Cork Harbour, 64 per  
 cent.

The high percentage of  
 pollution from industrial waste  
 in Dungarvan harbour accord  
 ing to these figures given at  
 the Cork Seminar would in  
 dicate a far more serious po  
 sition than that which the  
 figures of the monitoring ser  
 vice, which the local Urban  
 Council carries out, would  
 indicate.

## CHRONIC NEED FOR MORE L.A. HOUSES IN COUNTY

In areas of County Waterford  
 there is now a chronic need for  
 many more local authority  
 houses members of Waterford  
 County Council claimed at this  
 week's meeting in Dungarvan  
 when it was unanimously agreed  
 to stage a number of "housing  
 only" meetings during the year.

Fine Gael T.D. Austin Deasy,  
 highlighted the acute housing  
 problems in the seaside resort  
 of Tramore while the Chairman  
 Cllr Charles Curran said there  
 was an equally "criying need" in  
 several areas of West Waterford.  
 Deputy Deasy also hit out at  
 the housing levels in the Coun  
 cil's housing department where  
 he claimed two or three people  
 were trying to do the work of  
 ten.

We are being grossly unfair  
 to the few officials who are over  
 worked in this most important  
 of departments nor are we be  
 ing fair either to the general  
 public, Deputy Deasy said.

He went on to state that re  
 cently when four houses were  
 being allocated at Leamybrien  
 two of them were given to peo  
 ple who didn't even exist as far  
 as the housing list was con  
 cerned. That's how farcical our  
 housing situation has become,"  
 the Deputy added.

Mr C. A. O'Connor County  
 Manager said he believed that  
 the financial allocation they had  
 received from the Department  
 was exactly what they were go  
 ing to get in the current year.

The meeting decided on the  
 proposed by Cllr T. A. Kyne  
 seconded by Cllr Patrick Cahill  
 to press ahead with the acquisi  
 tion of land for housing by Com  
 pulsory Purchase Order where  
 necessary.
