LICENSING OF BULLS LIVESTOCK BREEDING ACT 1925

Applications for licences for bulls calved during the six months, January to Junc 1980, should be made not later than 31 January, 1981.

Applications should be forwarded to Section 9, Department of Agriculture, Agriculture House, Dublin 2, and accompanied by a fee of 25p per bull.

Applications received after 31 January will, if accepted, be subject to additional fees.

The inspections of the bulls will take place ONLY at approved centres (including Shows and Sales which have been designated as approved licensing contres) during February—March. Inspections of bulls on farms will not be carried out.

Bulls from herds, which are free of Bovine Tuber-culosis and Brucellosis need not be 30-day tosted before being moved to centres where inspections for licensing only take place. Bulls being moved to approved Shows and Sales where inspections for licensing and the award of premiums take place must, however, have passed a TB test and a Brucellosis blood test within 30 days prior to such movement.
