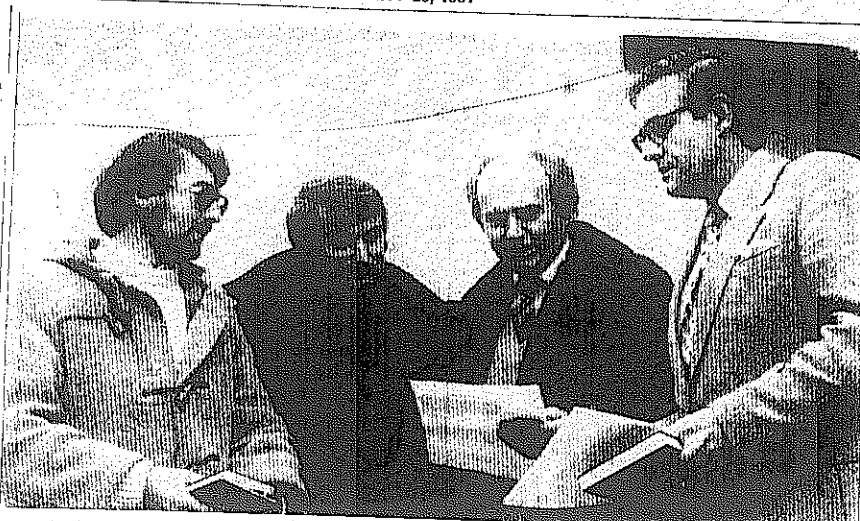

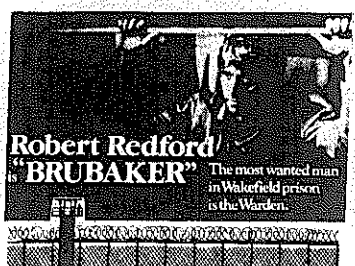

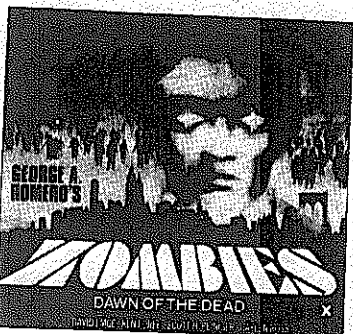

Peace Keeper Had Nose Broken

When a man intervened to make the peace between two others rowing in a Dungarvan licensed premises his nose was broken with just one blow and he spent several days in Ardara Hospital. District Justice W. F. O'Connell was told at Dungarvan Court.

Before the court was Michael Crotty, a glass factory worker of 23, Connaught Street, Dungarvan, and he pleaded not guilty to assaulting John Farrissey, Collier Road, Ardara, on October 19th last thereby occasioning him actual bodily harm. John Farrissey in evidence said he was in a licensed premises at Grattan Square, Dungarvan, on the night in question when he saw a row brewing between two men. One of the men, who was identified as another man, witness went between them to make the peace and received a blow in the face which smashed his nose and he was removed to Ardara Hospital.

Asked by Inspector J. Davis, prosecuting, who struck him, Farrissey replied, 'I'm not rightly sure'. The manageress of the licensed premises, however, said she saw Crotty abusing other customers and he was very insulting to them. She was very angry and said to Crotty, 'There is no need for that' and Crotty then lashed out and struck him in the face and Farrissey fell to the ground. She then asked Crotty to leave.

Sergeant T. Carly, Dungarvan, said that when Farrissey came to the Garda station that night he was covered in blood and his nose was twisted. Witness summoned a doctor and Farrissey was removed to hospital. The injured party claimed he had been struck by Crotty but when witness approached the accused he declined to make a statement. Crotty in evidence claimed he had been struck by another man and in turn struck him back. Farrissey then came between them and if he was hit the blow was accidental. Witness however did not believe he struck Farrissey.

Leonard Duggan, Clonety Villas, Dungarvan, said he was with Crotty that night and said he interviewed a row involving the defendant and another man. 'He was struck but I could not say by whom,' witness added. District Justice O'Connell said he had certain views and the manageress had given clear and unequivocal evidence. However, such was the evidence overall, he could not convict Crotty because the principal State witness could not say for sure who struck him. 'I must dismiss the charge in the circumstances,' District Justice O'Connell added.
