

**REPORT WARBLED ANIMALS** at once to the local District Veterinary Office or to the Department at Kildare Street, Dublin 2.

**DO NOT MOVE WARBLED ANIMALS** without an official treatment certificate issued after 1 February, 1981.

Contact your local A.I. centre (who will provide a free service for animals dressed under 1980 Scheme) or your veterinary practitioner about dressing warbled animals.

**REMEMBER** warble-free animals must be accompanied by treatment or exemption certificates issued after 15 August, 1980.

**Tenant Killing Ants In Council House**

When Cllr. Martin Walsh queried what repairs had been carried out to one of the Council houses at Congress Villas at the monthly meeting of Dungarvan Town Council he was informed by Mr. P. Walsh, Town Engineer, that the Town Foreman had inspected the house and more than two weeks work had been done on it. "There was still some work to be done," said Mr. Walsh.

Mr. Walsh then stated that he had been called from work a few days before the meeting by the tenant to go to the house. When he got there the woman was preparing dinner and he saw ants on the dinner plates

on the table which the woman was killing.

The Town Engineer replied that there was no way he could keep ants out of anybody's home. "That was a matter for the tenant concerned, not for the town council," he said.

"I have ways of dealing with them," said Mr. Walsh.

When Cllr. Walsh continued to express dissatisfaction, the Town Engineer said that he would speak to the tenant who was the Town Foreman and inform him that a member of the Council had complained that the work done was not up to standard.

## NEW EXTENSION OF FREE TELEPHONE RENTAL ALLOWANCE

Free Telephone Rental Allowance is being extended to the following groups:

- Recipients of disabled persons maintenance allowance from Health Boards.
- Recipients of social security Retirement Pensions from the United Kingdom who are aged 66 years or over.

Applicants must be living entirely alone or living with one person only who is permanently incapacitated.

**How to apply**

You should apply now.

Disabled persons can get application forms only from health board area offices. They must return them to their local area office.

Pensioners can get application forms at Post Offices and they should return them to the Department of Social Welfare, 157-164, Townsend Street, Dublin 2.

## INCREASED CHILDREN'S ALLOWANCES

Children's Allowances are also being increased from July 1981.

The present rates of payment will be adjusted and there is no need to apply for the increase.

## MATERNITY ALLOWANCE FOR WOMEN IN EMPLOYMENT

Women on leave under the Maternity Protection of Employees Act, 1981, may be entitled to a New Maternity Allowance from the Department of Social Welfare. Certain contribution conditions will have to be satisfied.

**Rate of payment**

The amount payable will be 80% of a woman's earnings in the 1979/1980 income tax year. There is a minimum payment of £45.75 a week.

**Duration**

The allowance is normally payable for 14 weeks. It may begin as early as 10 weeks but not later than 4 weeks before the baby is due.

**How to apply**

Maternity Allowance should be claimed two weeks before the maternity leave begins. Forms will be available at any local office of the Department or direct from the Department of Social Welfare, Áras Mhic Dharmada, Dublin 1.

## RESIDENCE CONDITION FOR OLD AGE (NON-CONTRIBUTORY) AND BLIND PENSIONS

At present, an applicant for either of these pensions must have lived in the State for periods ranging from 5 to 15 years. This condition is now being abolished.

## CHANGES IN PAY-RELATED BENEFIT

Pay-related benefit will be calculated on earnings between £20 and £170 a week from April.

Pay-related benefit will not normally be paid for the first fortnight of any claim.
