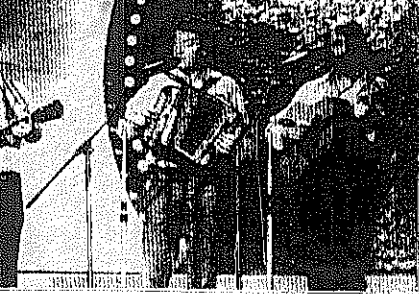

Dear Sir, As a result of the intimidation action taken by the Abbeyside Residents Association last week on the 3rd July and the subsequent and somewhat varied press coverage given to this event afterwards, I wish to make the following statement on behalf of the Company, its management, staff and employees.

In 1976, the Company purchased Victoria I quarry in 1967 for the disposal and digestion of non-toxic organic effluent from its tanneries. This involves a natural digestion and filtration process, which purifies the effluent as it flows through a series of tanks.

On the 26th June 1981, the Company decided to proceed with the preparation of Victoria II quarry, because of the serious risk of pollution from Victoria I as a result of a failure in the natural process of digestion and filtration.

Finally, I wish to state that the Company are most determined to resolve the present situation within the law and as a matter of considerable priority in such a way that no jobs are put at risk as a direct result of this dispute.
