European Communities (Restriction on Slaughter of Sheep)

On Slaughter of Sheep)

Regulations, 1981

The Minister for Agriculture has made Regulations, entitled as above, operative from 24 August, 1981. The Regulations provide that:

(a) Sheep originating in the United Kingdommay not be slaughtered in a slaughterhouse or meat export premises in the State unless they are accompanied by a Variable. Premium Clawback. Document (UK Customs Form C273(1))

(b) The Clawback Document must be surrendered to an authorised officer of the Department of Agriculture or the registered proprietor of the slaughtering premises or his agent.

(c) The Clawback Document is valid for three days only and all sheep imported for slaughter must be slaughtered within this period.
