

(No. 2) Act. 1960 or substituted by Section 30 of the Housing Act. 1960, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially projuded by any requirement of the Housing Act. 1966, as so extended not having been compiled with, may quash the order as so confirmed, either generally or in so far only as it affects any property of the applicant.




