the Clearance Area (Counties Carlow, Cork, Kerry, the Creartice Area (Coluniose Carpow, Corp., Kerry, Ribdate-Ribbenny, Laois, Limentok, Longford, Olfaly, Tipperary, Westerford, Westmeath, Wexford and Wickfow), into herds in Countlies Char, Dublin, Louth and Meath unless they are accompanied by official permish showing that they have passed a T.B. and Benceshosis test within 30 days prior to

and Seucedloss test within to turn the amount movement.

Animals, other than unimals from officially Brucelosis Free Herds or Brucelosis (Certified) Herds must be moved derectly into isolation and pass a further blood test after 60 days before being allowed to join such herds. A blood test 14 days after calving is also required if the animals are pregnant.






