At a special meeting held in Dungarvan last Monday members of Waterford County Council considered a variation in the Tramore Town Plan in respect of an application for Outline Planning Permission submitted by a newly-formed Company called Tramore Leisure Park Ltd.

The application, a grant of which is being sought, is for a development of approximately 120 acres situated on the eastern end of the 'new' promenade to the sandhills and northwards to be north the Tramore-Dunmore East road, forming a triangle.

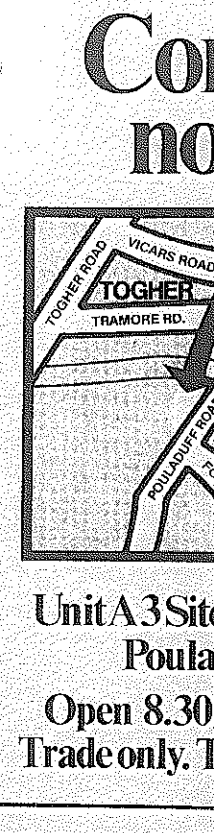
