Fire Call Failure Not Our Fault Says Postmaster

At the last meeting of Waterford County Council, Deputy Austin Deasy made a complaint that an emergency 999 call on September 9 had followed an outbreak of fire in a house at Grange near Youghal was not immediately passed on to the Fire Brigade Headquarters and that as a result of the delay the house and contents were completely destroyed.

At the Council's October monthly meeting held in Dungarvan last Monday the complaint was answered by Mr. J. J. Keenick, Head Postmaster-Cork. In the course of a letter to the Chief Fire Officer in Dungarvan Mr. Keenick under date September 24 had this to say:

"Thank you for your letter of 9th inst. I have had a thorough investigation carried out into the above complaint. The original request for emergency services was alleged to have been made at 11.50 a.m. on Sunday, 9th inst. The Exchange records for that date have been examined and they contain no mention of any such call having been received. Each individual member of the staff on duty has been questioned and all have stated that no '999' call was received by them at that time.

"The complaint states that when she asked the operator for emergency, she received the reply 'or that's fine.' I am certain that an operator would not use such a phrase, as all have been instructed to use the standard expression 'Emergency, which service do you require please?' I wish to inform you on a point of information that when '999' is dialled an extensive alarm system is set in motion in the Telephone Exchange. Loud buzzers ring at the back of the switchboards and they keep ringing until answered. At the same time bright red lights flash at various points throughout the room.

"A group of special operators is designated to give instant attention to any such call and this section is under constant supervision by our supervisory staff. In addition '999' circuits are tested every hour, on the hour, both night and day. When a caller states what service he requires he is put through to that service on a direct circuit and the operator continues to monitor the call to ensure that the caller has the correct service.

"A record of the call as then prepared by the operator and this is passed to the Supervisor for entry in the Telephone Exchange diary.

"I very much regret this unfortunate accident and its consequences, but I am entirely satisfied that no failure occurred in the emergency services on that date."

TRAGIC SUDDEN DEATH OF YOUNG DUNGARVAN STUDENT

The public demonstration of sorrow and sympathy for the bereaved parents and family seen at the Requiem Mass and the subsequent burial in the Old Churchyard on Tuesday evening following the sudden and unexpected death of Miss Mary Flynn, eldest daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Austin Flynn, Fountain Guesthouse, Youghal Road, Dungarvan on Sunday last has hardly ever been seen before in Dungarvan. The huge edifice was harked to the doors with the overflow congregation spilling out on to the Churchyard as Rev. Fr. Carey, C.C. commenced the Requiem Mass. The congregation consisted of young children, school girls and young students, principally from the local Presentation Convent where Mary had just finished her second level education a few short months before with a Leaving Certificate examination in which she scored honours in eight subjects. Also there were a large number of mourners from all over the town and before the sad ceremony concluded many tears had been shed by young eyes as well as old.

Aged only 17 years, Mary Flynn was the eldest daughter of Mr. Austin Flynn former All-Ireland Hurling star and popular senior official of the Hurling Board at St. Joseph's Hospital.

To her parents, Austin and Sybil, to her sisters Janet and Anne, her grandmother, uncle, aunts, cousins and relatives we join in tendering our heartfelt sympathy in their tragic loss.

COUNTY COUNCIL ADJOURNS AND VOTES SYMPATHY

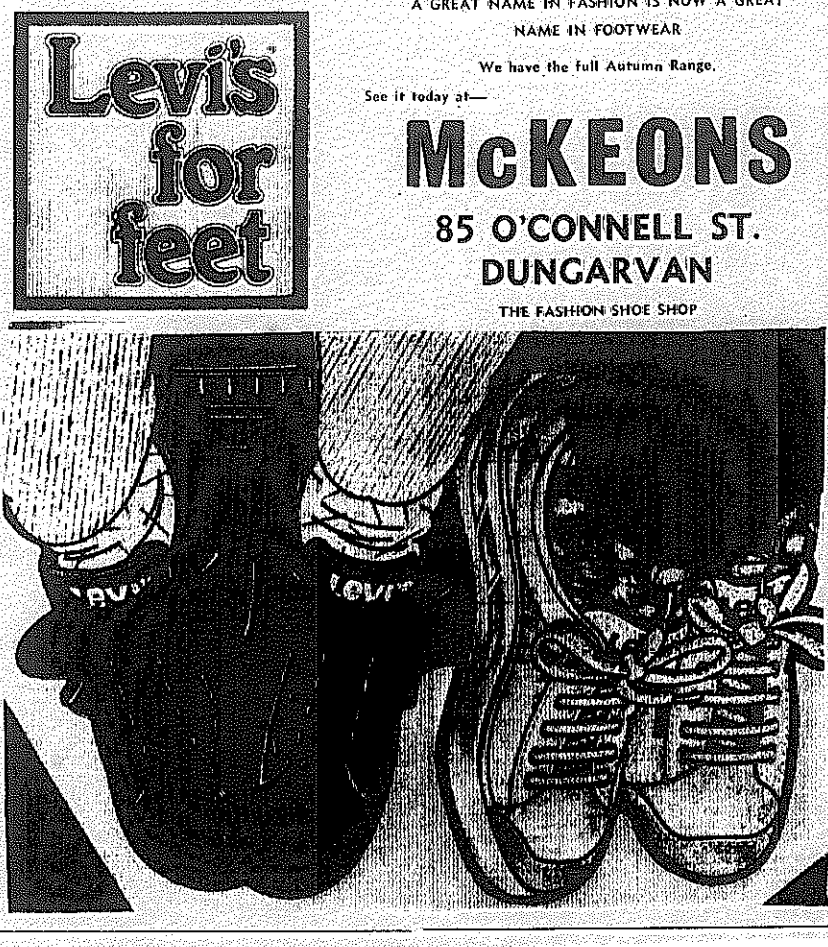
Waterford County Council adjourned its monthly meeting at 10.30 p.m. on Monday night at a mark of respect on the death of 18 years old Mary Flynn, eldest daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Austin Flynn, Fountain Guesthouse, Youghal Road, Dungarvan, who died with tragic suddenness at her residence on Sunday last, October 10.

Proposing the adjournment, Cllr. C. Curran said that Austin Flynn was a most popular senior officer of the Health Board stationed at St. Joseph's Hospital in Dungarvan, while Mrs. Flynn had been a former member of the Council's clerical staff. The unexpected death of their daughter which had occurred so suddenly the previous day had come as a great tragedy. He recalled that during the summer period she had worked in a hospital and had won the admiration and love of all the patients. He formally proposed that the Council's sympathy be extended to Mr. and Mrs. Flynn and the other members of the bereaved family.

Cllr. Curran also proposed that sympathy be extended to Mr. Paul Gerkin, the Council's Finance Officer on the recent death of his uncle.

On the proposal of Cllr. M. Timoney, the Council also extended sympathy to the widower and sister of the late Fr. Pierce Henery S.J. who died last week. Cllr. Henery stated that the late Fr. Henery (An tAiste de h-Indre) was well known in the Binn Gaeleagh where he had worked at the College for many years.

The votes of sympathy were then passed in silence and the meeting stood adjourned for a brief period as a mark of respect.

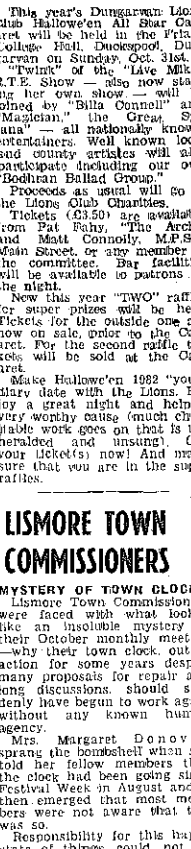
