APPEAL AGAINST CONVICTION UNDER WILDLIFE ACT FAILS

Joseph O'Callaghan, a 26-year-old steel erector, of "Meriville," Youghal, appeared at Dungarvan Circuit Court against a fine of £50 imposed on him at Talloe District Court, on September 16, when he was

convicted by District Justice Keenan-Johnson on a charge that he did, on May 23, 1982 at Glengaura, Carrigrohane, hunt a protected bird, to wit a pheasant, contrary to the Wildlife Act, 1976.

Mr. A. V. Mulvan, State Solicitor, for the Director of Public Prosecutions said that the case arose from a charge that the appellant shot a pheasant during the close season.

Mr. T. Slattery, B.L. (instructed by M. S. J. P. Gordon & Co. Solicitors) appeared for the appellant.

LABOUR PARTY NOTES

CONFERENCE

Dungarvan and Abbeystead delegates, Mossy McGrath, John Butler, Matt Flaherty, Tony Bones, Jimmy Byrne and Bill Kyrne, travelled to Limerick for the special conference on Sunday week.

346 votes to 822 the recommendation of the Party Leader, Dick Spring, T.D., to join coalition with Fine Gael was accepted.

Of the record this was the recommendation that put Labour into government.

That conference endorsed the report of the Party Leader on his negotiations with other political parties, in Dan Breen and mandates the Parliamentary Party to vote in accordance with his recommendations.

The conference speeches were very good with Michael D. Higgins giving a most emotive and stirring speech, a realisation. Newly elected Labour Deputy for Limerick, Frank Underhill, also made a quiet but very persuasive case for entering into government with the other political parties.

Mr. Kevin Taylor, T.D. met with the Abbeystead delegates and his comments to them showed him to be a most shrewd person.

Dick Spring confirmed his ability as Party Leader not only by setting his recommendation accepted but by the unity shown by all speakers and delegates at the conference. When the vote was counted and announced M. D. Higgins stated that he was disappointed with the outcome but was proud to continue the fight for Labour with Dick Spring.

THE FUTURE

Labour will have a tough job in government but the plan to tax the wealthy property owners and land speculators will be worked with interest.

At local level our Labour Councilors are planning all sorts of meetings with Tony Quinn, T.D., Labour spokesman on the Environment to see local authority rents assessed in a humane and understanding way.

Both our Urban Councilors have raised the matter of the bare letter boxes at Kilrush Park and while nothing has been done as yet this matter will be pressed until the necessary action is taken. The finishing of the road at Bayview was also raised and the County Manager has promised to investigate this complaint.
