





"The area of marginal land under forest in Ireland is shannefully low," says Mr. Noed Davern, outgoing Franna Fail, M.E.P. for Munster. "Last year Ireland imported imber and word products worth £118 million, yet 45 to 50 per cent of this figure could be replaced by frish timber."
