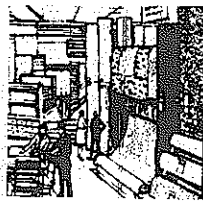

## KNOW YOUR RIGHTS COLUMN

### Q. — What tax allowance do single parents get?

A. — In addition to the ordinary personal allowance (£2,300 for married couples and £1,800 in other cases) the head of a one-parent family may also claim a special single parent allowance. This allowance amounts to £1,800 in the case of deserted/separated parents who are married parents in the case of a widowed person the allowance amounts to £1,800. A widow or widower with a one-parent family has a combined tax allowance of £3,600.

The criteria for qualifying for the single parent allowance are —

1. the claimant must be a widowed person or a person not able to claim the married person's allowance; or
2. the claimant must be entitled to claim the child tax allowance or the child benefit; or
3. the claimant must not be co-habiting.

Q. For what purpose does the Credit Union provide the loan? A. For any purpose which the Credit Committee considers to be of real benefit to the borrower.

### FIERY EXCHANGES AT LEATHER GROUP'S A.G.M.

The board of directors of Irish Leathers was criticised last Wednesday by two shareholders at the annual and extraordinary general meetings in Dublin.

The strongest criticisms were levelled by Dr. Richard Casey whose family holds about 2% of the shares of the group. Dr. Casey is son of the late Dr. M. A. Casey, Dungarvan, who was nationalised into the State leather factory (Dickens Leathers) in Dungarvan almost 50 years ago.

In a statement issued during the meeting to other shareholders Dr. Casey claimed that the company was "a nationalised company for political reasons; it would be nationalised at a time convenient to Fianna Fáil."

"During the ebb which followed the 1948, Dr. Casey said the company had been insolvent for some time and it was for that reason that Fianna Fáil were being given such good terms under the proposed conversion."

The meeting had before it a proposal to convert a £2 million loan from Fianna Fáil into 40% convertible cumulative preference shares.

Dr. Casey said that it was the word "convertible" which was the disputed. When Fianna Fáil decided to make the switch the group would then be in the control of the State, he argued.

Mr. Neil Hurley, group chairman, said that Fianna Fáil would be obtaining the Credit Office, 52 St. Mary St., Dungarvan.
