Court sequel to 'violent and vicious attack' by women in Dungarvan

A separated mother of two young children aged three and four years, who was one of four women involved in what District Justice W. F. O'Connell described as a "violent and vicious attack" on a young married man, was sentenced to two months imprisonment at Dungarvan Jail. Three-quarters of an hour later, however, the District Justice released and suspended the sentence.

The court heard that the man was attacked while he was walking along a road in Dungarvan. He was hit on the head with a bottle and on the face with a glass. His injuries included four cracked ribs and a head wound which necessitated 12 stitches.
