

1985 SHEEP HEADAGE SCHEMES

(1) Scheme of Premiums for Good Quality Ewes (EEC Regulation 1837/80 ETC.)

Under this Scheme compensatory premiums will be paid to flockowners on ewes which have lambed at least once or are visibly in nave lambed at least once or are visibly in lamb at inspection time. The rate of payment will depend on developments in market prices during the 1984/85 marketing year. An advance of 30% of the prenium for the full year will be paid in late February 1985 to flockowners in the Disadvantaged Areas. The balance (or full amount where no advance is paid) will be paid to all flockowners after the end of the marketing year.

(2) Sheep Headage Scheme in the Disadvantaged Areas (EEC Directive

A flockowner is eligible to participate in this Scheme if he occupies and farms at least 7.5 acres (3 hectares) in the Disadvantaged Areas and if his off-farm income combined with that of his spouse will not exceed £6,400 for the income tax year ended 5 April 1988. Subject to clearance by the EEC, rates, of payment will be £8.50 on each of the first 150 ewes in a flock and £5.50 on each of the next 50 ewes. Grants will be paid on:—

(a) mountain ewes (including hogget ewes) substantially maintained on mountain grazing and

(b) other hogget ewes in the applicant's ownership and possession on 1 January 1985 and present at a subsequent inspection.

APPLICATIONS A composite application form covering both Schemes together with Terms and Conditions is being issued to last year's participants. New or other applicants who do not receive a form before 4 January 1985 should contact the nearest Local Office of the Department, Applicants in the Disadvantaged Areas who replacants in the Disarvantaged Areas who wish to be paid the 30% advance of Ewe Premium for 1984/85 must lodge application forms with the Department's local offices not later than 11 danuary 1985 to enable the Department to pay the advance.
