For I can assure him that a knowledge of Irish is not exclusively confined to Sinn Feiners or the section of the Gaelic League that is driving the language movement to destruction.

With reference to his letter of above date he has certainly applied made up for the want of concession of the Rev. Chairman of the Sinn Féin meeting in the length and vehemence but evasion of the points he set out to reply to. He boldly asserts that instead of having benefited by the agitation of the past 40 years the farmers of Ireland on account of the war taxation imposed on the country are under a worse financial condition than they suffered under in black '47, and all, of course, owing to the treachery of Mr. Redmond and the Irish Party. I wonder he could point out a single farmer who would exchange his position to-day for that of his predecessor of 1847 or for what his own position was 20, 15 or even 5 years ago notwithstanding war taxation and Redmond's betrayal, which he so loudly trumpets. He further says that he shall pass over the abuses of Parnell. Of course I anticipated that any allusion to Parnell's leadership of the Irish nation could not be rebuked by Sinn Feiners, who, while professing admiration for what they term his great and worthy services to his country, try to degrade, denigrate and trample under foot the constitutional methods by which he advanced his country so far on the road to National Independence.
