

Dungarvan Urban Council

The weekly meeting of the Urban Council in the Town Hall on Friday last, Mr. M. Brennan, P.C., presided. Also present were—Mr. Butler, T.D.; Mrs. McConarty, J. Hackett, P. J. McGrath, M. J. and John Curran.

EXPENDITURE.
The expenditure for the week, as presented, was passed, amounting to 15s. 9d.

NEW ROADWAY AT ABBEYSIDE.
The Borough Surveyor explained the arrangement with Mr. Moloney, now opening a gateway at the end of a view to speeding up the work. Chairmen—That is very well, the sooner the better.

MARY STREET SEWERAGE.
Mr. M. Scanlan wrote—As we are aware from our interview last week that Pat Donnelly at the Urban District Council served a summons relative to some land at one of my houses. The summons called for leaving on Wednesday. Your Board would do me a great favour by making an order of withdrawal, equating up an outstanding matter and tenure of the premises where legal liabilities exist with the Board. My financial position presently allows me to expend a lump sum of £100. The Board by court order insist on the work being done, payment for same when my order is proved to the court could only be weekly instalments. The matter your hands for consideration. I have raised the property relative to the town by thousands of pounds who also supported every beneficial that arose during his lifetime in the town. Mr. McGrath—What has the Officer to say to that?

Chairman—Mr. Scanlan had a view with a few members of the Board and they asked him to come to a meeting. He did not come but by letter. This arose out of a report medical officer of health, and as a matter of fact we will be forced to go to it.

Mr. McGrath—If he has to be settled before Wednesday could he withdraw?

Chairman—That is for the Board to decide.

Sanitary Sub Officer—This is for some years, and the tenant, Flynn, is complaining, as is also next door. In his opinion, it would only cost a few pounds.

Mr. Hackett—If the council work and deduct the cost from the tenant and Mr. Scanlan meet for and talk the matter over or Mr. Scanlan would be the tenant, the cost of the work out of the tenant. Mr. McGrath—We could go for a fortnight.

Chairman—They have four days to settle, and if it is settled we can our solicitor to withdraw.

Mr. Curran—That would be the Chairman—If Mr. Scanlan proposes to fix it up with the tenant, withdraw.

Mr. Keane proposed, and the seconded, that Messrs. McGrath, Curran call on Mr. Scanlan with a view to making a settlement, and if it is arrived at to instruct the S.S.O. Mr. Williams to adjourn the case.

Mr. Butler—Before the case is drawn we must see that the matter is settled.

DRAINAGE AT HERMITAGE.
Mr. McGrath called attention to the want of proper drainage at the Hermitage, opposite the Catholic Power.

After a discussion the Borough Council was directed to send a report to the Council.
