Power, Defendant. O'Keefe, Plaintiff, who asked for a rectification of an agreement whereby the defendant agreed to let the plaintiff for a sum of £50 a number of trees in defendant's lands. The defendant claimed that the trees intended for sale were situated in a field known as the "Meadow Field," and complained that the plaintiff had also cut trees in the adjacent land to the defendant's house, which was stated, was not in the agreement.
