An Fear Mor, Vice-Chairman, at the monthly meeting of the County Waterford Vocational Education Committee at Scullin, Dungarvan, on last Monday evening, 22nd October, 1946, present—Senator J. Butler, T. Kyme, M. McGrath, D. L. Veale, W. Dower, M. Hanlon, M. O'Hara, M. T.D., Very Rev. Dr. Curran, Jas. Lanigan, C.E.O. LEAVE OF ABSENCE. A letter from the Department was received committing to grant leave of absence to Mr. McGrath, with pay to whole-time, desiring to attend at the Dublin, from Monday, 28th to Friday, 1st November, that suitable arrangements to carry on the work of the Department should be made. The C.E.O. said that Mr. McGrath's only teacher wishing to attend at the Dublin was Mr. O'Hara, if possible.

SEED TESTING. The increase in expenditure in the latter year is largely due to increased payments to officers of the committee on the raising of the cost-of-bonus in January, 1945, and the grant of additional sums in January, 1946, as a result of the bonus as from 1st Jan. 1946. It is recommended that in addition to the ordinary annual sales of books or stationery, done at present, a record should be kept of all purchases of books and stocks to be received, and close of each accounting period on sick leave for a period of months and could not receive the necessary supervision of school gardens; that a large portion of the garden produce at the garden centre is used in the kitchen, and that at Cappoquin garden is too small even to meet the needs of the domestic classes at the school.
