Kilkenny Dog Wins Deise Cup

Clonme Dogs' Double Successful Two-Day Meeting at Clonea

Favoured with relatively fine weather, a large patronage and excellent running hares, the Dungarvan Coursing Club had a very successful two-day meeting on last Wednesday and Thursday. On the first day two rounds of the Derby Trial Stakes, Deise Cup and the Oaks Trial Stakes were gone through, and on Thursday the card was completed. Everything was carried out with clock-work precision, which reflected great credit on the hardworking committee.

Most interest was centred in the Deise Cup, which was won by a Kilkenny dog. Do Rolly, owned by Mr. J. Dowling, of Talbot's Inch, Kilkenny, from Mr. T. A. Morris's Majuba. Mr. Morris got some measure of compensation when Marengo won the Derby Trial Stake from Mr. M. O'Connor's Cotton Raja. The Morris family were again to the fore in the Oaks Trial when Mr. A. Morris's Hurley's Bank Again took this stake.

When the Dungarvan Coursing Club announced its intention to run a two-day meeting this season there were many lovers of the sport in the town and district who viewed the decision with a good deal of misgiving and not a little pessimism. Perhaps there might have been some justification for the verities of these "longtail" fans, having regard to the fact that though the attractions of the sport is fast increasing in popularity, a young fist like the local one would have to work hard to compete with clubs better known and longer established.

The carrying through of the whole programme was the incident sustained by O'Connell Street King, the property of that well-known sportsman, Mr. Liam Morrissey, in the third round of the Highland Rum Stake, when his valuable dog met with a serious shoulder injury. It will be recalled that in the recent Kilkenny meeting, a litter sister to O'Connell Street King (O'Connell Street Baby) also met with a serious head injury.

Mr. Pax Whelan, Vice-President, in presenting the Deise Cup to Mr. Dowling, congratulated the winner, Mr. J. Dowling, on his success and thanked the donor, Mr. Paddy Lynch, for presenting such a beautiful cup to the Club.

In presenting the Ballymacanister Cup (presented by Mr. M. F. Walsh) to Mr. T. A. Morris, Clonme, the Vice-President said it afforded him much pleasure to present this trophy to the chief man in the coursing world.

And although none of the big prizes went to local owners, nobodies beguiled the lucky winners their successes.

HAIL INJURES HUNDREDS. PEOPLE RUSHED TO HOSPITAL. Hundreds were injured on Sydney's beaches in a severe ten-minute hail storm on Wednesday.

HALITONES BIGGER THAN A MAN'S fist bombarded the city, smashing windows and ripping through car roofs. From the famous Bondi Beach, alone, 50 people were sent to hospital in ambulance. At Sydney sports grounds an air raid shelter turned into an emergency first aid station was full of casualties.
