NOTICE

A SREAY THAT DOGS AND CATS SHUN. Ornamental plants on front porches, flowers and shrubs in the front garden, and the corner posts of porches, may be protected from damage by dogs and cats by the simple use of a dilute nicotine spray. This spray is harmless, but its smell is very offensive to cats and dogs, even when applied so thinly that persons are unaware of its presence. The name of the material is nicotine sulphate, and it is prepared by mixing one-half teaspoon of the nicotine sulphate with one gallon of water. This makes the mixture strong enough for ordinary circumstances. The spray evaporates and should be renewed if it rains otherwise in good weather spraying every two weeks is sufficient.
