Creamey Manager's Regretted Demise.—It was with feelings of deep regret that the people of Ballinamult district learned of the death of Mr. Cornelius Scanton, Manager of Ballinamult Creamery, Bruff, Co. Limerick. The late Mr. Scanton was aged about 60 years. A native of Fedamore, Co. Limerick, he was a well-known hurler in his early days, assisting Limerick County in winning a number of Munster Championships. Around 1914 he was appointed creamey manager at Newcastle, South Tipperary, and during that time he became acquainted with the people of Ballinamult, when it was mainly due to his untiring efforts, combined with those of the late Tommy Harralun, Ballinamult, that we had the establishment of a Hurling Club in the area, and the names of those two great Gaelic hurlers are remembered as pioneers of hurling in the district. Later this team fully justified the confidence placed in them when they contested the Junior Hurling County Final and were unluikely beaten by the small margin of 1 point by Clonsilla. In the early days of the Anglo-Irish struggle the late Con Scanton became an active member of the I.R.A. His prowess as a soldier soon became manifest and earned for him the distinction of being appointed Coy. Captain at Newcastle. This position he filled well and truly during those years of hope and endurance. The suffering and privation endured by the faithful son of Ireland in his unflinching stand in the bearna boghall of Ireland's hopes and fears, no doubt, shortened a life of devotion to his country. The funeral took place to Bruff Cemetery and the attendance, representative of all classes, was the largest seen at Bruff for some years. The coffin was draped in the tricolour and members of the O.I.R.A. formed a guard of honour.

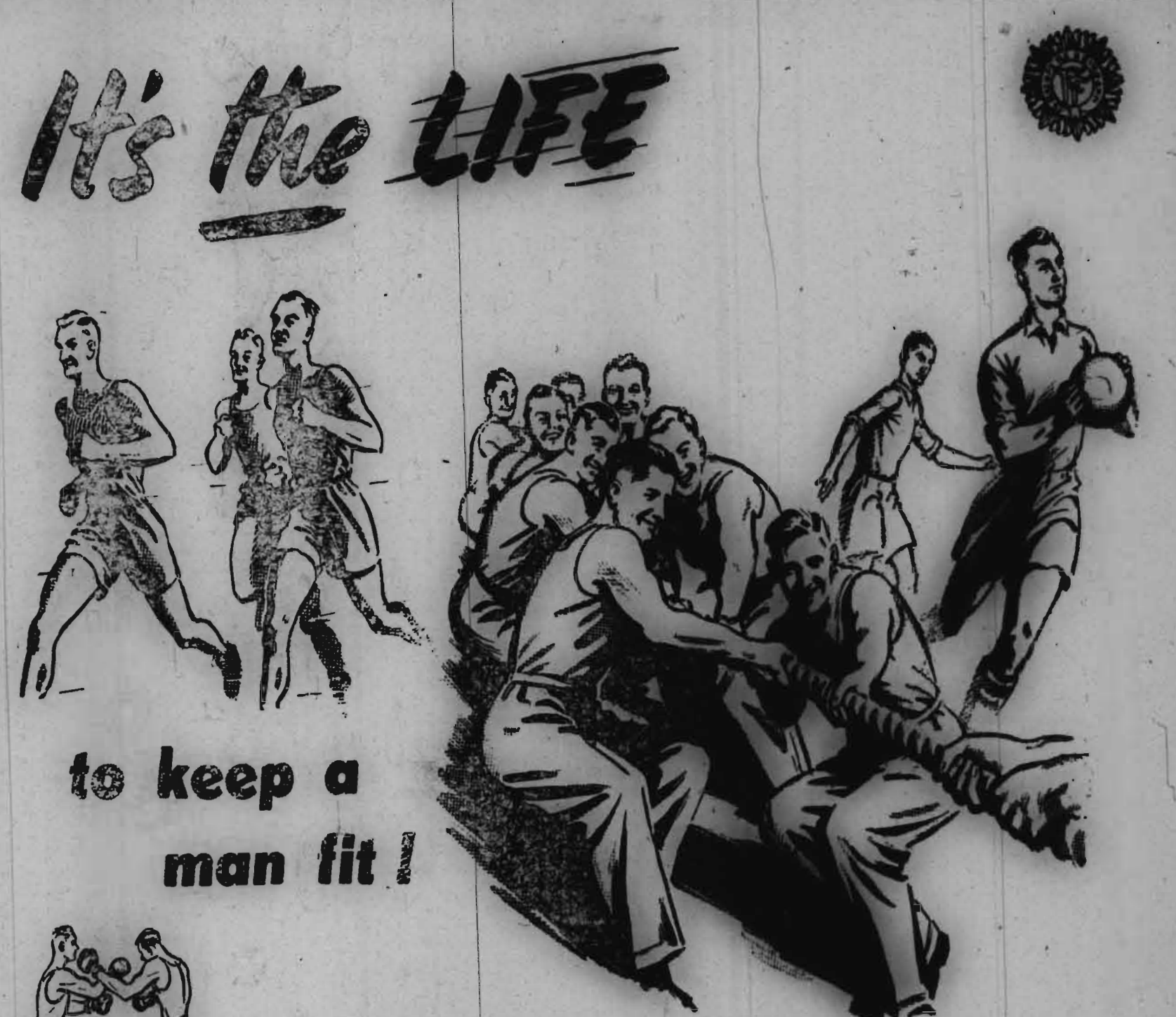
