Poultry Development Scheme.

Subsidies on Chickens Distributed from Licensed Poultry Hatcheries and Approved Poultry Stations. The Minister for Agriculture has approved of the operation, during the forthcoming hatching season, of a Scheme whereby subsidies at the following rates will be payable to licensed poultry hatcheries and approved poultry stations on chickens of high quality sold by them at prices not exceeding 15/- per dozen in the case of "as hatched" chickens and 30/- per dozen in the case of boxed pullets (both prices being inclusive of the cost of delivery). RATES OF SUBSIDIES: (a) Chickens distributed during the period 21st November, 1950, to 10th May, 1951, inclusive. 5/- per doz. on "as hatched" chickens. 8/- per doz. on "sexed pullet" chickens. (b) Chickens distributed during the period 11th May to 31st May, 1951, inclusive. 2/6d per dozen on "as hatched" chickens. 4/6d per dozen on "sexed pullet" chickens. Subsidies will be payable only on chickens distributed by poultry hatcheries which have been licensed under the Poultry Hatcheries Act, 1947, and by poultry stations operating under the Poultry Stations Scheme administered by the County Committees of Agriculture, or the Department of Agriculture.
