Four members of the Bank Officials Association were subpoenaed to attend. These officials, however, maintained they were seeking direct negotiations with the Irish Banks' Joint Committee. They were unwilling to submit a case to the Labour Court and answered only questions to which answers were legally required.

EFFECTS ON COMMUNITY - Coming after Christmas, the strike of Bank Officials caused fewer difficulties for the public than might have been the case at any other period of the year. The extra money which came into circulation during the Christmas period, and would otherwise have been deposited in the banks is still in circulation. This is now being used for the ordinary purposes of business. Trading concerns are facilitating each other, those with cash on hand providing others who have not cash businesses with money. Shopkeepers are not experiencing very much difficulty though there is a tendency on the part of most of them to conserve change which they fear might run short. This is particularly the case in smaller premises with the result that people with slot meters are finding it hard to get coppers and shillings for their gas meters. The January sales have helped to keep money in circulation and the additional cash which they have brought on to the market has eased the situation. Cinemas, shops and restaurants, all of which do a cash business, are the money changers.

PRICES ADVISORY COUNCIL - The appointment of a Prices Advisory Council, under the Chairmanship of Mr. Justice Levery of the Supreme Court was announced in Dublin last week. At the same time the Government has announced a price-freeze over a comprehensive list of commodities. Effect is being given at once to the "price-freeze" and it is retrospective to December 2nd. All prices which have been increased since that date must be reduced to their original level. In addition to 24 food commodities already price-controlled, the Government will apply a wide range of other foodstuffs, industrial materials, household goods, entertainment, all kinds of clothing and materials, agriculture, motor-cars and parts. The new Council will review the prices of goods and services and adjudicate upon applications for increases in prices. It will also give general advice on prices to the Minister for Industry and Commerce.

RECORD STEEL OUTPUT - The steel industry at Haulbowline, Co. Cork, has had a record year's output. A point made by the Chairman at the third annual meeting was that it is provided in the Articles of Association of the company that no dividends can be paid so that the profit after payment of taxation goes back into the industry. A large reserve is necessary, not only for the purchase of replacement plant but also as a cushion to meet the impact of the competition from the large steel-producing countries, when the present stringency of steel supplies comes to an end. "It is the policy of the directors of the company," the Chairman stated, "to keep Irish steel prices as low as possible, and in pursuance of that policy, prices were reduced by almost 10 per cent in January, 1950, and after the end of the year under review by almost 8 per cent. On the other hand, prices of similar foreign steel have risen steeply. On the basis of present prices, Irish steel is now being purchased by our customers on advantageous terms compared with foreign steel. In fact we would have no difficulty in securing orders for steel from other countries in the United States in September, at prices considerably in excess of the price now charged to our home customers. This high quality which we claim for the company's products has been testified to by our customers, and it is the policy of the Directors to maintain the reputation gained in this respect. Even before the shortage of steel now experienced, it had become the exception rather than the rule to use foreign steel when similar Irish steel was obtainable."

ARMAGH HARVARD - The Baker-Schmidt telescope, the most powerful instrument of its kind, which was shipped from the United States in September, has now been mounted at Bloomfontein. The telescope which is owned jointly by Armagh, Harvard and Dunster Observatories is claimed to be capable of penetrating farther into the Milky Way than any other instrument. It was built to the design of the German astronomer, Schmidt, with improvements by Harvard optical expert Dr. Baker. It has two mirrors of 36 and 16-inch diameter and a "lens" which is actually a correcting plate of complex design.

EXTENSION OF DRAINAGE SCHEME - Thousands of acres of land in North Kerry, which for almost seven months of every year are useless because of flooding, will benefit when the Brick and Cashen drainage scheme is undertaken next summer. In the area there are 18,000 acres of flood land, and even in June of a fine year, traces of deluges can be seen. In a green field the visitor could see a line of reed and twig left by the flood-high tide mark, as it is cyclically described locally. Present plans are that drainage work will start in the summer and it is hoped that some 600,000 bushels of wheat will again wave a welcome to the reaper where there is nothing now but marsh and wasteland.

SEA FISHERIES - The total quantity of salmon and sea trout taken during 1949 amounted to almost 2,250,000 lb., valued at £408,065, according to the report on Sea and Inland Fisheries for 1949, issued by the Department of Agriculture. This compares favourably with output for the preceding two years. Landings of herrings and mackerel declined in 1949 compared with 1948 because fewer of those fish shoaled in Irish waters but landings of other popular fish increased. The in-shore landed the great bulk of the fish. In 1949 the number of persons engaged solely in sea fishing was 1,913, a figure very slightly less than that of 1948. The number, 8,150, of persons partially engaged was less than in 1948 by 114, and this reduction may partly be attributed to the comparative failure of the herring and mackerel fisheries. The numbers of vessels employed in 1949 as compared with 1948 were respectively: motor vessels, 619; and 631; sail-boats, 729 and 734; row-boats, 1,978 and 2,036.

MORE TRAVEL BY NATIONAL AIR LINE - Aer Lingus, the national airline, carried 22,500 passengers in 1949, an increase of 30,000 over the previous year. This figure included 2,055 babies. The Dublin-London route was, as usual, far the busiest, with a total of 105,675 passengers. The general increase in the number of passengers was 15 per cent. Freight traffic showed an even greater all-over increase. During the year, 2,340 tons were carried in cargo services, as compared with 1,940. The adjudicator is Sir Arnold Bax, the distinguished composer.

RADIO CONTACT WITH AMBULANCES - Hospitals in Galway may soon have wireless communication with their ambulances while the vehicles are out on duty. As a result of experiments made, it is believed that difficulties which have been encountered can be overcome. Apart from enabling the hospital to call in an ambulance in case of emergency, the system would mean a great saving in time and mileage by diverting ambulances to answer calls in the districts where they operate. It sometimes happens that an ambulance returns from a long-distance call to find awaiting it another call from the district it had just left.

433 NEW COMPANIES IN 1949 - In 1949 the number of new companies registered was 433, according to the report of the Department of Industry and Commerce. The total number of companies in the United States was valued at £1,205,383 for the period as compared with £368,399 for the previous year. In the eleven month period the value of fat cattle exports was £5,303,403 in the 1949 period. The total value of all live animals exported was £27,232,801, an increase of almost three million pounds on the 1949 figure.
