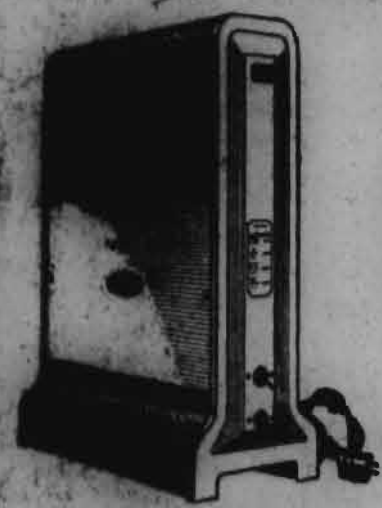

Fresh from their recent triumph with their production of 'The Swan Song' the members of the Ballinroad Dramatic Society have immediately got down to work on the preparation for a new play.
