

Tolly Portalis. These were not the same daughters who attended Mrs. F. at Civita Vecchia. The unmarried daughters dined at the table. Her Majesty embarked on board the *Clorinde*. His Lordship and Lady Charlotte Lindsay embarked with her, so did Mrs. F. and her two daughters, so did Dr. Holland. His Lordship and Lady C. Lindsay disembarked at Leghorn. After this his Lordship did not see her Majesty till November, 1815, at the Villa d'Este. He then saw her Majesty on the Lake of Como. Lady C. Lindsay was then in England. He dined with her Majesty at the Villa d'Este; Bergami sat at the table; he never saw him sit at table before. He went away that evening, slept at the town of Como, and went to Milan on the Saturday following. He dined with her Majesty again and again at Milan. He did not recollect having had any intention of staying with her Majesty; his intention was to travel, and he had no wish to delay. He dined at Milan on the invitation of the Queen; Bergami dined there also. He had not seen the Queen since.

Earl of Guilford cross-examined by the Attorney-General. His Lordship had seen Bergami wait at table at Civita Vecchia. He did not recollect Bergami waiting at table at Naples, or on board the *Clorinde*. He could not charge his memory, but he did not recollect that it was so. Lady Charlotte Lindsay held the situation of Lady of the Bedchamber to her Majesty, and quitted it in the beginning of May, 1817. Though Lady Charlotte took this situation, she did not remain in it after quitting the Queen at Leghorn. There were other Ladies in the Villa d'Este. He saw the Countess Odi there. He conversed with her; she did not speak the *patois* she spoke tolerably good Italian; she used a little of the accent of Lombardy, but not more than many well-bred persons of the country. He saw the Queen's grounds. He had a Greek servant. Her Majesty showed me a part of the grounds herself, and then lent me her donkey, *jackass*. (A laugh) to ride over the rest. He mounted the donkey opposite the door, when they quitted the olive-garden. He saw her Majesty afterwards about the grounds. He did not recollect seeing his servant conversing with her; it might have been so, but he did not remember it. He had never stated that he saw her walking round the grounds with his Greek servant; he had never stated that he had seen his servant in conversation with her Majesty; he did not recollect any thing of the kind. His servant might have been about the grounds, but he did not recollect having seen the Queen walking with him. He did not recollect seeing his servant about the grounds. He had never on any occasion stated that he had seen his servant with the Queen in the grove, or near the grove. Had the circumstance really happened, it would most likely have struck him, but he did not recollect any such thing. It might have happened. It was hardly probable that he could have stated any such thing. To the best of his recollection he had never witnessed any thing like it. He knew that Lady Charlotte Lindsay quitted the service of the Princess, he had no conversation with her, but she is his sister, and he corresponded with her; he advised her to resign her situation. Never observed any improper familiarity between the Princess and Bergami; certainly not. The Countess Odi appeared perfectly indifferent in her manners, perfectly modest, and not vulgar, but not remarkably refined; saw her when he called on her Majesty, once at the Villa d'Este, and once at Milan; had heard before, that she was the sister of Bergami. At dinner, witness sat on the right of the Princess, and Bergami at the other side; observed no particular attention of the Princess to Bergami; the Countess Odi sat on the other side of witness; Wm. Austin, Lieut. Howman, and a medical gentleman, were present. When he saw the Princess and Bergami in the boat, Bergami was rowing. The Princess did not introduce Bergami, or Mr. Howman, to his Lordship. The department of Bergami to the Princess was nothing particular, but very respectful. Lady C. Lindsay left the service of the Princess of her own accord.

Lord Glenberrie, examined by Mr. Will. Witness was with Lady Glenberrie, at Genoa when the Princess was there. Lady Glenberrie acted in the suite of her Royal Highness, during the absence of Lady Charlotte Campbell. He and Lady Glenberrie frequently dined with the Princess. Saw Bergami every time he dined there; his conduct to the Princess was that of a servant, and respectful; if any thing particular had occurred, witness must have observed it. This was in the year 1815. Her Royal Highness was visited by Mrs. Falconer, her two daughters, Lieut. Howman, Dr. Holland, the Marquise Carlo Nazare, and an English officer of the navy. Thinks he saw Lady W. Beaufort. Was present at the only ball given by the Princess, and saw there the principal Ladies and Gentlemen. The cross-examination of Lord Glenberrie was brief, and elicited nothing of moment. Lady Charlotte Lindsay was the next witness called; she was accompanied with a chair, and examined by Dr. Lushington. Her Lordship formed part of the suite of her Royal Highness; entered into her service in the year 1808; went abroad with her in 1811; was one of the Ladies of the bed-chamber. On that journey, went as far as Brunswick. Saw the Princess again in Naples, in 1815. Joined the Princess in the beginning of March, and staid as long as she remained at Naples; accompanied her from Naples to Rome; thence to Civita Vecchia, where they embarked on board the *Clorinde*; quitted her Royal Highness at Leghorn, which was the arrangement be-

fore they went. Her Royal Highness was visited by all the English of distinction at Naples, and by all the Neapolitans of rank;—by Lord and Lady Londonderry, Lord and Lady Holland, Lord Clive, Lord and Lady Oxford, Mr. Davenport, Sir W. Gell, and Mrs. Falconer. Was on board the *Clorinde*; the cabin was divided, and the Princess slept in the one half, and the Captain and his brother in the other. The Princess expressed some surprise that the other half had not been appropriated to the use of the witness. Bergami was in the service of the Princess, as a courier; he conducted himself in the usual way of a servant towards his mistress; the conduct of the Princess towards him was that of a lady towards her attendant; never observed any impropriety of conduct between the Princess and Bergami. Left the service in 1815; in doing so, witness complied with the request of her brother; has seen her Majesty since her return to this country. Cross-examined by the Solicitor-General. Joined the Princess in Naples about ten days before she left it. Saw Bergami at Civita Vecchia; her Royal Highness and witness walked out, and Bergami attended at a short distance behind; believes Hieronymus was also a Courier, but that he did not walk out. Cannot say as to the exact number of times they walked out; Bergami attended every time. Does not think that the Princess and Bergami walked arm in arm; if they did, it must have struck her; she might have taken his arm, but witness has no recollection of it. Her situation led her frequently to the bed-room of the Princess; saw Bergami in the bed-room, for it was there, unless when there was company, that they used to dine, Bergami always in waiting. The Princess, Wm. Austin, and witness, dined there together. Witness always dined there, except one day, when she went to Pompeii. Quitted the service in 1817. The House, after some unimportant proceedings, adjourned. FRIDAY, OCTOBER 6. The Lord Chancellor took his seat about the usual time, and prayers were read. On the names being called, his Lordship begged leave of absence for his Royal Highness the Duke of York on account of indisposition. The Counsel were then called in, and the cross-examination of Lady Charlotte Lindsay was resumed by the Solicitor-General. Her Lordship remembered that there was a garden at Naples, called, we believe she said, La Veterina. She had walked one day in that garden with her Royal Highness; Bergami was present. Her Lordship accompanied her Royal Highness from Naples to Rome, and was in the same carriage; Bergami rode as courier. Her Lordship was also in the same carriage with her Royal Highness on their departure from Rome to Civita Vecchia, and she believed that Bergami still rode as courier, but she could not so distinctly recollect that, as in the former part of the journey. Being asked if she recollects in the former part of the journey Bergami coming up to the window of the carriage, and saying to her Royal Highness, "A voi, Madame?"—her Lordship perfectly recollects in one part of the journey Bergami coming up to the carriage, after being called, and saying, "A voi, Madame." There were provisions in the carriage. The Princess gave him something to eat, and something to drink. She had no distinct recollection that it was after he was called, but she thought it was. There was no circumstance which enabled her Lordship to pronounce with certainty; it was merely an inference which she drew from her own mind, because it was more natural. She had no distinct recollection one way or the other. There was nothing in the circumstance which struck her as at all remarkable. There was a bottle of wine in the coach; she thought that Bergami drank out of the bottle without a glass; she could not be quite certain; she fancied that he returned the bottle; she could not be certain in any way. The Princess and her Lordship had been taking refreshment; she could not say whether Bergami returned the bottle or threw it away; she rather thought he returned the bottle to the carriage.—Her Lordship had no distinct recollection of having stated, after she had made up her mind to quit the service of her Royal Highness, that it was a great relief to her mind that she had come to that determination of quitting the service of the Princess; she did not remember having stated anything to that purpose or effect. She might have stated it, but she did not know that she ever had done so. Her Lordship could not recollect having stated that it was a great relief to her mind that she had determined on quitting the service of her Royal Highness, for that no woman of quality, who had any regard for her character, could remain in that service. She could not recollect having stated any such thing in any such words, nor any thing to that effect. She would not say that she had not said them, but she had no recollection of having used any such words. She believed she could say for them. The Earl of Donoughmore resumed his examination.—Had certainly seen nothing improper in the conduct of her Majesty, but there were reports of some degrading nature as to render it unpleasant to remain in her Majesty's service. Examined by Lord Falkland.—Did not observe in her Majesty's conduct to her male and female servants any familiarity derogatory to her character and situation; her Majesty was exceedingly affable and familiar in her conduct to all her servants. Thinks the manners of the higher classes in this country much more reserved towards their servants than that of foreigners, which is more unreserved; and thinks her Royal Highness's manner was peculiarly so. Could not say whether her Majesty's manners appeared peculiar in that respect to foreigners. When she said she had not observed any impropriety in her Majesty towards Bergami, nor any impropriety in Bergami's behaviour towards her Majesty, she had reference to that peculiarity of her Majesty's behaviour to

which she had adverted. Don't know that anything she observed would have appeared to any extraordinary or becoming. Her Majesty appeared to talk to Bergami as she did to several others in her family. By the Earl of Lonsdale.—The request of her brother, in consequence of which she quitted R. H.'s service, was communicated in writing. His not the letter in her possession. [Being asked if the difficulty she had experienced in receiving her salary was stated as the ground on which that request was made?] Mr. Brougham objected to the question, the existence of the letter not having been proved. Does not know if the letter is in existence; had made no search for it. [Some discussion took place here, as to the necessity or propriety of desiring her Ladyship to search for the letter, which ended without producing any immediate decision.] Could not collect whether she was in the habit of going to her Royal Highness's bed-chamber when at Naples, without having been sent for; never entered the chamber without knocking. The arrangement of leaving the service of her R. H. was made by a letter from her R. H. in which her R. H. intimated her wish, that as her Ladyship was still on the Continent, she should join her in her answer, and witness consented to do so, but added, that she would not leave her R. H. until she had received a letter from her R. H. which she might have the advantage of her brother's company in travelling in England, where she wanted to arrive at a particular period, and could not travel alone. In answer to the Solicitor-General.—It was about June, or July, 1817, that she left the service of her Royal Highness. Her Ladyship was here desired to withdraw.—The letter was then again brought into discussion, at the conclusion of which the Lord Chancellor said the witness must be desired to search for it. The Earl of Lansdowne and the Hon. Keppel, Chayen were afterwards examined, but want of space, and a desire to give their evidence without curtailment, obliged us to postpone its insertion till our next publication.
