DUBLIN ELECTION COMMITTEE.
The committee met this day at 12 o'clock, when Mr... Hutton proposed to give up the vote of Christopher... Dempsey, on the ground of bribery.
Mr. Thesiger objected to the evidence of this witness... being read, and urged the reasons assigned by the com... mittee for placing the evidence on the rejected sheet... It appears that shortly after the election an affidavit had... been sworn by the witness before a magistrate of the county... Dublin, named Curtis. This affidavit was traced to... Mr. Murphy's possession. A requisition was presented... to produce the affidavit, which he refused to comply... with. This means the petitioners were deprived of an opportunity... of testifying his evidence.
The committee decided as follows:—
"Resolved—Although the committee have declined to... exclude evidence in bribery cases on mere technical ob... jections, in this case they considered the refusal to... produce the affidavit as a wilful exclusion of important evi... dence by the sitting member's agent. Under all circum... stances however, they will allow Dempsey's evidence to... be read, but cannot act upon it unless strongly corroborated..."
Mr. Hutton then proceeded to read Dempsey's evidence... which clearly proved the fact of his having been paid a... sum of £4 in Jones's, in Exchequer street, to which he was... sent by a man named Kent.
At three o'clock the committee decided as follows:—
"That it appears to the committee that no corrobor... ation of Dempsey's evidence having been adduced, his name... must remain on the poll."—Adjourned.
