...this was the prophecy of one who knew something about
the shooting of guns. He hoped that the noble friend
would persevere and still bring in his bill (Cheering).
But he had some doubts. It was not an unusual thing
member who was really desirous of bringing in a bill to
grant as an instruction. The right hon. baronet op-
posed (Sir James Graham) had said that the ministers
were spell-bound; but were the people of England spell-
bound also? Was it fair to represent to the noble friend
England that the church was in danger by this measure,
and that the Protestants of Ireland were to be deprived
meet the people of England on this point. He was not afraid
to pay the ministers of the established church; but the
improvement of the morals and religion of the great
masses of the people. A resolution stood recorded in the
journals of the house, that any surplus, after providing
for the Protestant clergy, should be so applied. The
government were only endeavoring to perform the duty

The right honourable baronet had been the victim of his
own policy, and upon his fall the present ministers had
adhered to the principles upon which they came into
office. As an Irishman and a Protestant, he was most
anxious to give tranquillity to his country, and security
to the established church. (Cheering.) This was a
middle boat. His dearest interests were bound up with
the interests of his country, and he hoped that the same
credit would be given to him for sincerity in this respect
as he was ready to accord to the noble friend. As a
man who had some stake in Ireland, he could say that
there could be no repose in the country until this ques-
tion was settled. If £50,000 annually, paid from the
surplus of church property, were to give peace to Ire-
land, why quarrel with such an application of it?—
The people of Ireland, and the Protestants of Ire-
land, were interested in the surplus of the church prop-
erty of the country. This would be the means of
saving the Irish church. The appropriation
clause was not objected to; but it should be recollected
that on a former occasion the title bill was objected to
without the appropriation clause, and if they stopped
now a still greater objection would be demanded here-
after. He thanked the house for the attention with
which he had listened to, and had he not deemed it
necessary he should not have trespassed on them so
long. (Cheers.)

The house then divided, when the numbers were—

Majority for ministers 39
The other orders of the day were then disposed of, and
the house adjourned at a quarter past three o'clock.

The CHANCELLOR of the EXCHEQUER did not
intend to trouble the house at any length; but there
were some statements made by the right hon. bar-
onet, which appeared to be very much
beside the real question. Was it right for the hon.
gentleman, on an important question of this kind,
to occupy himself and the attention of the house in
insisting on comparisons between the salaries of the
members of the House of Commons and the salaries of
the members of the House of Lords? There was no
analogy whatever between the two cases. The hon.
right hon. baronet had put, except indeed, it was drawn
from the provision in a former bill, respecting the 25
parsons of whom they had heard so much. He thought
the hon. baronet could have attracted the attention of
the house by a more judicious selection of subjects,
amongst these was the question of remuneration, which
must be taken into account in this and every future bill
on the same subject. The great principle which they
had to give them in such cases was to apportion the
remuneration to the service done, and where no duty was
performed, there should be no remuneration. If the
principle advocated by the right hon. baronet would
be for Tanworth were to be adopted, the hon. baronet
would be guilty of a crime if they did not apply to the con-
sultative fund for additional salaries for the poor English
clergy, and the hon. baronet had not a tenth part of the amount
allotted to the duties of the clergy in respect to the opinions
imputed to them (the government) which had been ex-
pressed by others at this side of the house, he begged
to remind honourable gentlemen that his Majesty's in-
sistors were responsible only for their own opinions and
their own arguments; but a fair construction had not
been put on them. The hon. baronet had said that the
hon. baronet had expressed his approbation of the prin-

no hesitation in saying that he was entirely against that
